Series #5: Rhyming

Say a pair of words. Ask your child to identify whether or not they rhyme (circle their answer; correct answer in bold):

sun/fun	Y /N
gate/gum	Y/ N
float/coat	Y /N
jump/thump	Y /N
fan/lane	Y/ N

Ask your child to say a word that rhymes with each of the words below:

top - can - let - best - stack
